# Tasmanian Catholic Education Office Police Check FAQ's

#### Q How to I apply for a police check?

A Applications are available at any catholic school/college or can be downloaded from the TCEO website www.catholic.tas.edu.au

Applications must be submitted to the school or college that you wish to volunteer or work at.

#### Q How long does the application process take?

A The application process can take up to 6 weeks, however, most applications are processed and returned to the schools within 3 weeks.

#### Q How long will I be registered for?

A Each registration is for a maximum of 3 years. Printed on each certificate is a valid "start" and "end" date.

#### Q Why do I really need to supply 3 pieces of identification?

A It is a Tasmania Police requirement that you supply 3 separate pieces of identification. A list is provided on the application form. If you do not, your application will be sent back.

#### Q Can I use a police check that I already have?

A Yes, as long as the police check meets these 2 requirements:

- \* the police check must also be less than 6 months old
- \* the police check must be the original so that the delegated person at the school can take a copy and certify as a true copy of the original

### Q How do I know that I'm registered?

A Once your application has been approved, a certificate will be issued and send back to your school. This certificate is yours to keep, please note that it is an original.

## Q Do I need a Commissioner of Declarations to sign my police check application?

A No, any person over 18 years of age can be a witness.

## Q Can I get a copy of my certificate or my police check?

A The certificates that are issued from the TCEO are originals and we do not keep copies. Each certificate is pre-printed with the registration number.

Unfortunately, the TCEO is unable to provide copies of individual police checks and this is a directive from Tasmania Police.

## Q My registration is about to expire, how do I renew my registration?

A Once your registration has expired or is about to, you must re-register, including filling out the application form and providing identification.

## Q If I volunteer at different schools, do I need to be registered at each school?

A No, apply for registration at the school at which you have the most contact and then show your pocket sized registration card at any other school.
